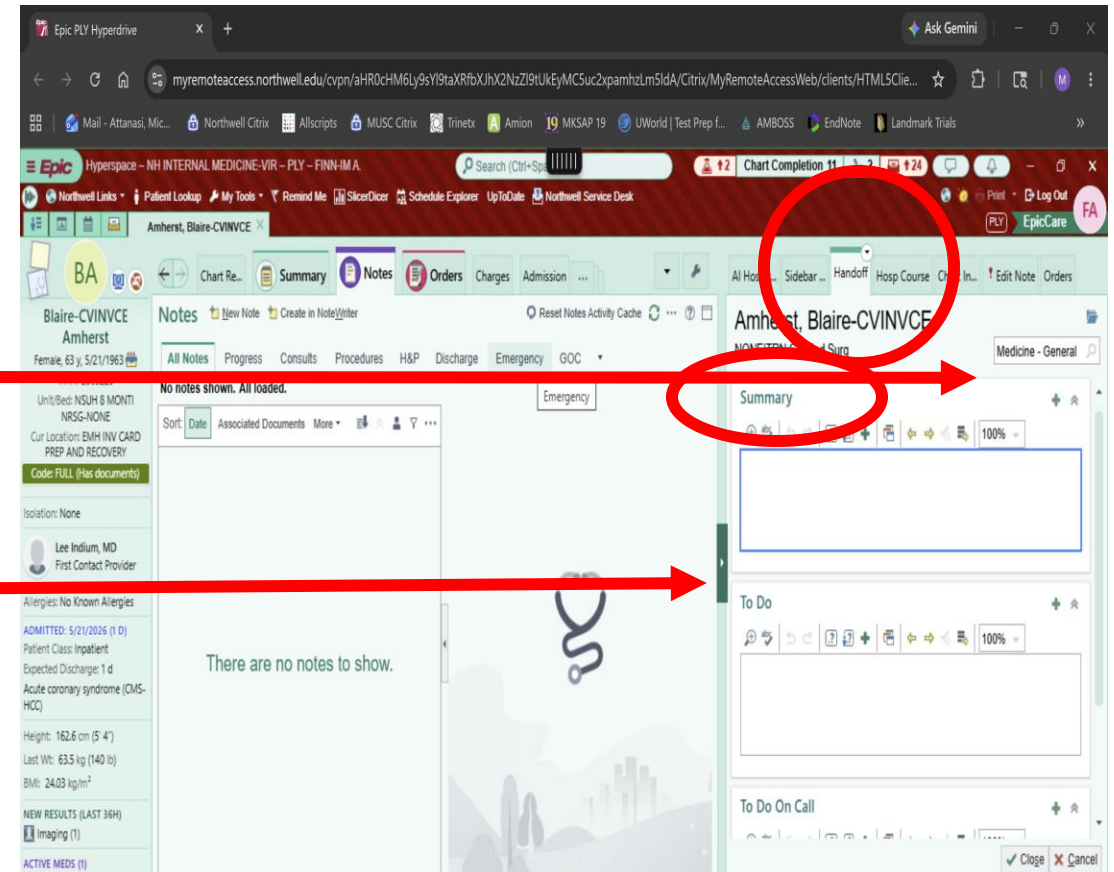


How to Write Notes in EPIC

by Your 2026-2027 Chiefs :)

- Note: **Every Day Before You Open an H&P or Progress Note, You MUST Update the "Summary" Section of the Provider Handoff.** This Is Because the Assessment Auto-Populates into the Patient Note from the Handoff and CANNOT Be Refreshed
- The Handoff Should Automatically Be Assigned to Your Context(Medicine, MICU, etc)
- You Can Find the Handoff by Clicking the SideBar
- **I Recommend You Update the Handoff Summary Every Night Instead, Before You Print Your Handoffs**
- Do **NOT** Update "Severity" Sections
