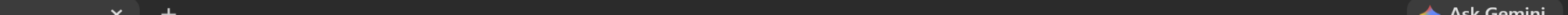

Important Considerations

- **Note: The ED will Also place and Admission order. DONOT DELETE THIS ORDER.** The ED Admit Order should remove the "hard stop" from the admission order set "admit to" order. However, you may need to order another admit to medicine order separately (within the panel). This workflow will be figured out more later
- You Should Put in the "Notify Provider" Parameters
- I Would Suggest Not Ordering Labs from the Admission Set
- I Would Also Order "Order Panels" Separately, So You Don't Generate Lag
- I HIGHLY Recommend Ordering the Appropriate Order Panels on Admission, So That You Reduce the Number of Flags and Alerts (Such As Sepsis Order Panel, etc.)
- Once the Admission is Done, Confirm with the ED and Floor Nurse Regarding Patient Orders, etc.
- Make Sure Telemetry, CPO, Isolation, etc. Orders Are Placed PRIOR to
